## Global Christian Leaders Arrive in Germany for The Wittenberg 2017 Congress

*The 3-Day Summit Seeks to Synergize the Church to Complete the Great Commission*

**BERLIN, Germany** (October 31, 2017) – The Wittenberg 2017 Congress began yesterday at the Maritim Berlin Hotel in Berlin, Germany. The plenary sessions of the summit, attended by over 750 Christian leaders, are taking place in Berlin’s most beautiful and technologically advanced theatre, the Hall Maritim. For the final session, attendees will gather in All Saints Church in Wittenberg, Germany.

Dozens of world-class speakers, representing millions of church members worldwide, are scheduled to give keynote addresses during the 3-day meeting. Held on the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Martin Luther posting his 95 Theses, the Wittenberg 2017 Congress is a gathering of Christian leaders from over 60 nations. The summit is part of a strategy to synergize the entire Body of Christ towards *Finish 2030*, a movement to bring the Gospel to the remaining unreached peoples across the world by 2030.

“The Wittenberg 2017 Congress creates an unparalleled opportunity to launch the *Finish 2030* global thrust for the completion of the Great Commission,” said Dr. Glenn Burris, president of the Foursquare Church. “I am thrilled to witness firsthand the synergy across major denominational lines worldwide.”

Dr. Timothy Hill, General Overseer for the Church of God, challenged The Wittenberg 2017 Congress with six-fold steps of FINISH. “We are going to find, intercede, network, invest, send and harvest until the Great Commission is completed,” said Hill.

“Leaders who attend this once-in-a-lifetime event will be renewed in heart, revived in mind, and released to go out and mobilize the Church towards *Finish 2030*,” said Dr. James O. Davis, founder and president of the Global Church Network and co-host of The Wittenberg 2017 Congress.

The Wittenberg 2017 Congress is the only event of its type planned for the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the start of the Protestant Reformation. In addition to experiencing presentations, attendees of the summit will be engaged in intercessory prayer, seeking the Lord for courage for the future, for harmony in the Body of Christ, and for fresh vision pertaining to the Great Commission.
